I am writing with some important updates, reminders and advance notice of our arrangements for the Easter break.

Last day of Spring Term – Friday 4th April

Students will follow normal lessons until period 3, then register with Form Tutors at 12:10pm before dismissal by 12:30pm. An extended break (10:40–11:10am) will be provided for food purchases. The usual fish/sausage and chips lunch will be available on Thursday 3rd April.

First day of Summer Term - Tuesday 22nd April

Students should arrive in school and be in their form rooms by 10.50am for registration with their Form Tutors. Students will then go to period 3 at 11.10am. Please remember that we return to School on a week A timetable and there will be no breakfast or break time provision for students on this day; lunchtime will operate as normal.
